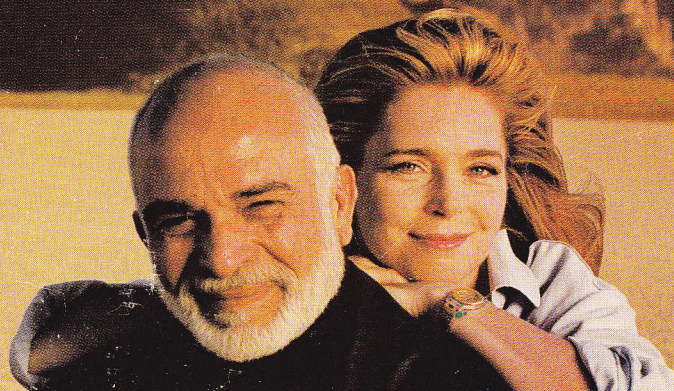

The wrought-iron rooftop rooster may be fine for some people, but not for Travis Tuck, America's premier weathervane maker, who forges whimsical works (often under the scrutiny of passersby) at his studio in Vineyard Haven. Starting at about \$2,500, all Tuck's creatures are pricey—and climatically correct. Beyond that, though, they're rugged individualists, with shapes and spirits of their own.
